

## CHAPTER 11

### TRANSPORTATION ACCOUNT CODES

#### 11-1. GENERAL.

a. DoD 4500.32-R [reference (a)] prescribes that Transportation Account Codes [TACs] shall be developed and maintained by each authorized DoD Component. The purpose of TAC codes is to identify the appropriate DoD Component and appropriation chargeable for movement of materiel through the Defense Transportation System [DTS] which requires reimbursement for services rendered.

b. In addition to identifying the chargeable organization and appropriation, TACs also identify the billing address; that is the address of the organization or accounting station responsible for the appropriation classification to be charged.

#### 11-2. TACs. The following TACs are authorized:
